9. How is faith related to understanding? (Heb. 11:3)
10. How is evolution a faith based system?
11. Is scripture plain and clear that God is the Creator?
12. How does being the Creator and saving Israel connect in Hezekiah's prayer? (Isa. 37:16)
13. If God is not powerful enough to create in 6 literal days then how could He be powerful enough to save people out of troubles?
14. Does God speak the truth? How does that relate to God and creation? (Isa. 45:17-19)
15. How do wrong considerations not fit with the implications of creation? (Isa. 40:26-27)
16. Who organized the heavenly bodies? What implications does this have? (Isa. 40:26)
17. What should you know and understand? (Isa. 40:28)
18. What problem does it create for us that God's wisdom is unsearchable? (Isa. 40:28-29)
19. If He is the source of all creation then what else is He the source of to those who wait on Him? (Isa. 40:29-31)
20. How does Jeremiah contrast the One who created and the man made substitutes of God? (Jer. 10:10-16)
21. Who causes the storms, evaporation of water and lightening? (Jer. 10:13-14)
22. Why are men foolish? (Jer. 10:14)
23. What does the Creator do with man's ideas? (Isa. 44:24-25)
24. Why does God confirm His words and confuse man's words? (Isa. 40:24-26)
25. How is God being Creator and future judgment relate? (Rev. 14:7)
26. On what or who should you consider in the days of your youth? (Eccl. 12:1)
27. Why should one not "sow his wild oats" in his young years? (Eccl. 12:1)
28. What does 1 Peter 4:19 say about relating rightly to your Creator?
29. How should you respond to God as Creator? (Psa. 95:6; 119:73)
