3. How can you “joyfully concur” with the law of God in the inner man and still be imprisoned to the law of sin? (Rom. 7:22-23)
4. Do you sense such conflict in living the Christian life? (Rom. 7:23)
5. Why does Paul exclaim “Wretched man that I am?” What does that phrase mean? (Rom. 7:24)
6. What does he mean by being set free from the body of this death? (Rom. 7:24)
7. What is he thankful for in verse Ro. 7:25?
8. Is the remedy to the miserable state Paul talked about to just ignore it or just accept it? Does God provide a better solution to it? (Rom. 7:25)
9. What is that solution? (Rom. 7:25-8:3)
10. What is the “law of sin?” (Rom. 7:25)
11. Who are those that have no condemnation? Do you have a no condemnation position with God? And why? (Rom. 8:1)
12. What does it mean to have no condemnation? (Rom. 8:1)
13. What does the phrase “law of the Spirit of life” mean? (Rom. 8:2)
14. What did Christ do which the law could not do? (Rom. 8:3)
15. How did Christ fulfill the requirement of the law “in us?” (Rom. 8:4)
