Study Questions

1. Does the indwelling Spirit communicate to you through groanings, what the will of God is? If so, how does this help you to pray according to the will of God? (Rom. 8:26-27)
2. By what means does God cause all things to work together for good? (Rom. 8:27-28)
3. What kinds of things does God cause to work together for good? (Rom. 8:28)
4. Define “good” by God’s standards? Can this good be painful and hard by human standards? (Rom. 8:28)
5. God causes “everything to work together for the good”, for who? (Rom. 8:28)
6. Who are those who love Him? (Rom. 8:28)
7. Who are those called according to His purpose? (Rom. 8:28)
8. How did God take the evil and turn it to good? (Acts 2:23)
9. What should be your perspective when people may intentionally plan evil against you? Or, if people do unintentional harm to you how should you respond? (Gen. 50:20)
10. What has God predestined for those “called for His purpose? (Rom. 8:28-29)
11. What does it mean to foreknow? (Rom. 8:29)

12. What does predestined mean and what benefit does that provide in the process of living in the Spirit? (Rom. 8:29)
13. What does it mean to be conformed to the image of His Son? (Rom. 8:29)
14. What tools might God use to do this shaping and are you willing to accept any painful ordeal to become like the Son?
15. How do you know that you are being conformed? (Eph. 4:24)
16. How does Heb. 5:8 fit into being conformed in the image of the Son through suffering?
17. What does predestination mean?
 - a. Acts 2:23
 - b. Acts 4:28
 - c. Eph. 1:5,11
18. Explain the meaning of “call?” (2 Thes. 2:13-14)
19. What does it mean to be justified and how does that effect the way you function as a Christian? (1 Cor. 6:11; Rom. 5:8-10)
20. What is the idea of being glorified? (Rom. 8:30)
21. Is there in any missing gaps in God’s ultimate purpose of bringing you to glorification? (Rom. 8:30)
