## Study Questions

1. How does one become justified? How do you know that you are justified? (Rom. 3:20,24; 5:1)
2. If you are justified, what does it mean looking back to God's foreknowledge and also looking forward to glorification? (Rom. 8:30)
3. Who are the "whom" that are being talked about? (Rom. 8:30)
4. If a person has been justified is there anything that could stop them from being glorified? (Rom. 8:30)
5. What should be your response to the things God has planned? What should be said about it? (Rom. 8:31)
6. How is God "for us?" ( Rom. 8:31)
7. How do these verses about God's favored presence help?
  - a. Ps. 23:4
  - b. Ps. 56:9, 11
  - c. Ps. 118:6-7
8. Who is against us? (Rom. 8:31)
9. What kind of assurance is God providing "for us?" (Rom. 8:32)
10. What does it mean to not "spare His Son?" (Rom. 8:32)
11. What is the distinction and emphasis of the Son offering Himself and the Father not sparing the Son? (Gal. 2:20; Eph. 5:2)
12. What could be the implications if the Son was unwilling to be sacrificed by the Father offering Him up or if the Father was unwilling in the actions of the Son to sacrifice Himself? What do both attitudes of willingness teach us?
13. What kind of comparison is being made with the actions of the Father with the Son and with the Father and His adopted sons? (Rom. 8:15,19,23,29,32)
14. How is Isaac described and how does it parallel the Father with the Son? (Gen. 22:2)
15. What does God do that Abraham did not do in relationship to his son? (Gen. 22:10-12)
16. What kind of emotion and tension do you sense in the possible sacrifice of Isaac? How does this instruct us about the actions of the Father with the Son for us? (Gen. 22)
17. What is the desire of the Father for the Son in Isa. 53:10? Why did He desire this?
18. Why does it refer to Jesus as "Son" and not as the Christ or some other name? (Rom. 8:32)
19. How do these verses help us to understand freely given? Look for different words.
  - a. 1 Cor. 2:12
  - b. Phil. 2:9
  - c. Gal. 3:18
20. What are these things that are freely given? (Rom. 8:31-32)
