4. If you take any other route in your life then to enter into an abiding devotional relationship with Christ, where will it lead you?
5. Is it true that if one does not desire to change out of their sinful path or pattern that the main reason is they don't consider it important enough to have an abiding relationship with Christ?
6. If you don't keep His commandment do you really abide in His love? (John 15:10)
7. What are the three benefits of abiding in Christ? (John 15:7-10)
8. What two elements must be present for your prayer request to be "done for you?" (John 15:7)
9. How is the Father glorified? (John 15:8)
10. In what kind of love can we abide in? (John 15:9-10)
11. How does the fullness of joy fit into Jesus discussion of abiding in Him?(John 15:11)
12. What does it mean that "I no longer live but Christ lives in me?" (Gal 2:20)
13. How do you live now that you are Christian in your physical body? (Gal 2:20)
14. How do you live by faith in the Son of God? Are you living that way now? (Gal 2:20)
15. Does the love of Christ mean enough to you that you would live for Him? Does the personal sacrifice of Christ mean enough to you that you would no longer live by the controlling influence of the flesh? (Gal 2:20)
16. How important is the Holy Spirit in becoming a believer and also walking as a believer? (Gal. 3:3)
17. How might you know if you personally are living by the Spirit? (Gal. 5:22)
18. How have you crucify your passions and desires?(Gal. 5:24)
19. Why is it significant that the Spirit dwell in you? (Rom. 8:11)
20. How does the Spirit give life to your mortal bodies? (Rom. 8:11)
21. What are you not obligated to live according to? (Rom. 8:12)
22. If you live according to the flesh, what kind of death must you die? (Rom. 8:13)
23. How do you by the Spirit put to death the deeds of the body? (Rom. 8:13)
24. How is it that if you "put to death the deeds of the body" that you are really living? (Rom. 8:13)
