### Week 8 Worksheet

**Passages to Read:** 2 Cor. 3,4,5: (3) note the contrasting glory, (4) the reason not to lose heart (5) the contrasting ideas; Eph. 4:22-32: the way the renewed mind thinks; Heb 12:1-4: Considering Christ attitude and activity

### Study Questions

1. By what process does one get transformed? (Rom. 12:1,2)
2. How does it describe God's will? (Rom. 12:2)
3. How would you know if you are renewing your mind? (Rom. 12:2)
4. What does it mean that God's will is good, pleasing and perfect? (Rom. 12:2)
5. Is there any other "will" that is intrinsically good?
6. For those saved by mercy is there any other "will" so pleasing as God's?
7. What other "will" could be as complete as His will?
8. So why would you not prove with great effort what is God's desire, His will?
9. How do you practically prove God's will? (see for ideas of how in 1 Thes. 5:21; 1 John 4:1)
10. What divine activity takes place that would cause you to not lose heart or be discouragement? (2 Cor. 4:16)
11. How often is this renewal taking place? (2 Cor. 4:16)
12. Does the producing of eternal glory happen automatically in the face of earthly affliction? (2 Cor. 4:17,18)
13. What kind of look or perspective is verse 18 talking about if the unseen is the more important? (2 Cor. 4:18)
14. Note the contrasting perspectives communicated in 2 Cor. 4:16-5:9? (Example; outer man vs. inner man)
15. How would you aim your mind to have the same renewing process happen to you that was happening to Paul and Timothy? (2 Cor. 4:16-18)
16. What consideration did Paul have concerning present sufferings compared to the future eternal importance? (Rom. 8:18)
17. From what source and from what kind of information did he come to such a consideration? (Rom. 8:14-23)
18. How does the veil get removed from the heart? (2 Cor. 3:16)
19. What does He transform us into? (2 Cor. 3:18)
20. How do we position ourselves to be transformed? (2 Cor. 3:18)
21. What does it mean to be "beholding ... the glory of the Lord?" (2 Cor. 3:18)
22. How does 2 Cor. 4:6 relate to "the glory of the Lord" of which we are to look into?
23. What does it mean to be renewed in the "spirit" of your mind? (Eph. 4:23)
