16. What is the Word of God profitable for? Define each of the terms. (2 Tim. 3:16)
17. What happens if you don't listen to the teaching of the Word? (Pro. 5:12-14)
18. What is just part of the "way of life" if you are being wise in the Word of God? (Pro. 6:23)
19. How do you know when the word is correcting you? (Rom. 2:20)
20. How do you get from a baby-like status to a mature Christian status? (Heb. 5:13,14)
21. How are you now training yourself in righteousness with the word? (2 Tim. 3:16)
